



Re-think the space!

Undergraduate Program in Interior Design - September 2017 intake

BRIEF

Applicant is requested to re-think and re-design an existent space. A space which he/she does not like or that he/she will improve. It can be a room in his/her house, an exhibition space, a shop environment, a hotel lobby, ...

Applicant is asked to describe why he/she does not like it, how he/she will transform it into something new (also by taking into consideration "innovation" and "multifunctional" properties). Applicant can use the preferred means of expression (sketches, collage, maps, etc.).

AUDIENCE

The competition is addressed to the students with a great passion for product, interior, architecture and urban design. Participants must have a high school diploma.

JURY

Projects will be selected and evaluated by the Faculty of the program.

REQUIRED MATERIAL

- 1 PDF file with max 5 A4 pages, including the project and a picture or a drawing of the design before and after and a brief description of the process.
- Statement of purpose (see guidelines here below)
Please write an essay (max 500 words) elaborating the following questions:
In the next future:
 - what job would you like to do after you graduate?
 - why did you choose DOMUS ACADEMY to achieve that?
 - what are your favorite means of expression?
 - what or who inspires you?
 - how living and studying in Milano will positively influence your work?
- Copy of Secondary School Diploma Certificate (translated in English or Italian)
- Copy of Secondary School Academic Transcript (translated in English or Italian)
- Domus Academy Undergraduate Application Form*

The candidates are asked to send their materials in one sole file in .PDF format. Any further attached material will be considered a plus and will be evaluated by the jury.

*** Application fee is waived for competition participants.**

PRIZES

- One scholarship covering 60% of the total tuition fee of the Undergraduate Program
- One scholarship covering 50% of the total tuition fee of the Undergraduate Program
- One scholarship covering 40% of the total tuition fee of the Undergraduate Program

Prizes will be calculated on the standard tuition fee amounting to €21.500 for non-EU students, and €14.990 for EU students.

SCHEDULE

The works must be delivered to Domus Academy by and no later than **March 17th 2017**.

Candidates will be informed about the results of the competition by e-mail on **April 10th 2017**.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Students in the Undergraduate Program in Interior Design experiment and practice with design at different scales, from large to micro interventions from urban scale to interior design to the elements of artifacts. The student evolves on knowledge, technical skills and organizational abilities to be autonomous for group leadership or creative direction. Through this Undergraduate Program students integrate soft and hard skills, which prepare them for current and upcoming career opportunities in a global arena and encourage them to generate new disciplines within the realities of space yet to be discovered.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates holding a valid Secondary School Diploma that was conferred on completion of minimum 11 years of previous global schooling and with a knowledge of the English language (IELTS 5.0 academic or equivalent certificate).

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Every moral or authorship right as to the project remains property of the author.
- The projects sent to Domus Academy will not be returned.
- All the material must be the result of an unpublished work developed by the candidate, not to be used in other previous occasions.
- Domus Academy is entitled not to award the scholarship if the projects are deemed not to meet the suitable standards defined by the jury. The jury will judge at its own discretion and its decision is final.
- The scholarship presented in this public announcement cannot be combined with other economic reductions offered by Domus Academy.
- The scholarship will be deducted from the balance of the tuition fee.
- The assigned scholarship which will not be confirmed could be transferred to the next candidate in the ranking list.
- Participants that will be selected accept that part of their work will be published on Websites and/or Social Media channels of the institutions involved.
