1. WHY YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS COMMUNICATION

3. FOR WHAT PURPOSES WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Nuova Accademia S.r.l. processes your data for the following purposes:

- a) To fulfil pre-contractual and contractual obligations, to allow your admission in the course of your choice, as well as the provision of services connected to it, such as verifying the prerequisite qualifications (e.g., diploma, degree) to access our courses.
- To handle money collections and payments (application fee), including credit recovery.
- c) To provide support services to certified disabled students or to students with certified learning difficulties.

Within the scope of the purposes above, the processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract (Art. 6(1)(b) of GDPR).

3.1 Data retention

For the purposes referred to in point 3, lett. a), b), c), d), e) and f), we retain your personal data for the whole duration of the time you spend on Campus and even beyond the 10-year period of limitation from the termination of the relationship to comply with legal obligations and for purposes of judicial protection.

For the purposes referred to in point 3, lett. g) and h), we retain your data until consent is revoked and we guarantee the exercise of data subjects rights.

For the purpose referred to in point 3, lett. i) and j), we retain your data for 3 years.

4. THE SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Your data will be processed using equipment that guarantees their confidentiality, integrity and availability. The processing is carried out on paper and through computerised and/or automated systems and will include all of the

GENERAL INFORMATION

A. AUDIENCE

The faculty reserves the right to check the proficiency of a candidate for any reason to take a final decision on his/her eligibility and to give final feedback on the application. The evaluation of an application is based on the positive assessment of both the Programme Leader and the Admissions Committee who will evaluate whether the diploma and the technical skills corresponds to requirements.

General entry requirements for accredited programme (Degree programme) include:

- At least 12 years of previous Education
- If applicable, depending on the country in which the student pursued the secondary education, passing **national test or final exam** (with a certain score if applicable depending on the education system) necessary to enter a higher education institution
- Holding a valid Secondary School Diploma that satisfies the requirements to enter Italian university
- Certificate of English language (IELTS 5.0 Academic or General on entry see section "English Language Certificate")

DIPLOMA PROGRAM:

General entry requirements for non-accredited programme (Diploma programme) include:

- Hold a Secondary School Diploma
- At least 11 years of previous Education
- Certificate of English language (IELTS 5.0 Academic or General on entry see section "English Language Certificate")

Participants not holding a valid Secondary School leaving qualification that satisfies the requirements to enter Italian university (and/or the English level required) will not earn the 3-Year Bachelor of Arts and the educational credits. They will enroll into **three-year private courses** (Diploma Program – not accredited) following the course structure of the program validated by NABA (except for the internship) and they will receive a **Domus Academy diploma** which is a private title, not recognized by MUR, Ministry for Universities and Research on successfully completing the program.

B. ADMISSION PROCESS

Within 7 days from the application submission, Domus Academy Admissions Office will inform the candidates about the acceptance and, in case of positive feedback, will send the Admission Package to the students. The admission will stay conditional until the above-mentioned entry requirements are accomplished according to the program and validation chosen.

C. DEADLINES

Applications can be sent within official deadline given in the competition brief. Please notice that applications will close after the official deadline and incomplete applications will not be accepted.

If eligible, students are required to secure their place by returning the Enrolment Form and the receipt of payment of the pre-enrolment fee within the official deadline given in the Admission Letter; the acceptance of a possible scholarship is strictly bounded to the deadline provided and, if deadline expires, the scholarship is meant to be no longer valid. Any possible scholarship will be deducted from the balance of the tuition fee (please see general conditions).

D. 3-YEAR BACHELOR OF ARTS (AWARDED BY NABA - 180 CFA/ECTS)

To receive a **3-Year Bachelor of Arts recognized by the Ministry for Universities and Research (MUR)**, students have to be enrolled/matriculated in NABA (Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti). NABA is a non-state institution belonging to the Ministry for Universities and Research (MUR). The 3-Year Bachelor of Arts lead to the attainment of legally recognized degrees and to the achievement of educational credits that will allow students to continue their studies in Academies and Universities in Italy and abroad.

E. MINISTRY FOR UNIVERSITIES AND RESEARCH: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for admission to Italian universities/academies and therefore to be admitted into the Domus Academy Bachelor of Arts Degree Programmes, the Italian Ministry of University and Research has set the following mandatory regulations. Students wishing to enrol in the 3-Year Bachelor of Arts Degree Programmes must meet the following requirements:

■ [FINAL HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA] possess an official higher secondary school diploma belonging to the foreign system of reference and issued by an official institution of the same foreign system and that shall grant access to the first-cycle courses in the foreign system of reference. The applicant's academic qualification shall be equivalent to the Italian qualification required to enter first-cycle programmes.

Specific Diploma cases:

- the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma is valid for admission to an Italian university if:
 - Total score must be 24 min comprising of:
 - 3 Higher Level (HL) which total score must be at least 12
 - 3 Standard Level (SL)
 - Having obtained scores for:
 - Extended Essay
 - Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
 - Creativity, Action, Service (CAS)

Specific case: if a student only attended the last 2 years of an IB Diploma Path, it must be verified that the total length of studies is 12 years from primary schools especially if taken in a country where the normal length is 11 (f.e. Colombia, Russia).

For details relating to the legalisation of IB Diplomas, please refer to the <u>relevant page on the website of the Italian Consulate</u> in Geneva

- The IB Career Related Programme (IBCP) is considered eligible for admissions to Bachelor Degree (*Diploma Accademico di* 1° *livello*) programmes as long as it includes subjects related to the programme of interest, namely Arts & Design subjects. The IBCP leads to a high school qualification of a professional nature. The IBCP curriculum consists of three different elements:
 - at least two courses from the IB's Diploma Programme (DP)
 - the CP core (comprising of all 4 mandatory subjects)
 - the career-related studies (i.e. the Btec diploma in Art & Design)

the **IB International Baccalaureate "certificate"** is not valid for admission to an Italian university for the Bachelor Degree – Diploma Accademico di Primo Livello programmes (only access as auditor can be evaluated)

U.S. High School diploma

Students obtaining a US high school diploma, in addition to their final diploma, should provide NABA with:

- Al least 3 Advanced Placement Tests (APs) exams, the minimum score required for each one of the APs exams is 3 (AP subjects must be listed as officials and indicated in the <u>College Boards official website</u>) or
- University transcripts of one complete year of studies

US High School Diploma + APS exams/University transcripts should be legalized by the beginning of the courses. The translation for documents issued in English language is not needed.

Private US High schools must be listed in official "Accrediting Agencies list" from the U.S. Department of Education here: http://www2.ed.gov/admins/finaid/accred/accreditation_pg6.html#RegionalInstitutional

British Qualifications

In order to be eligible to enter BA Degree Programmes, students holding British upper secondary school leaving qualifications must have passed at least three advanced level subjects (A levels), thus with gradings from E up to A. Scores not accepted are F (failed) and U (unclassified). Students holding Scottish upper secondary school qualifications must have passed at least three Advanced Highers or, alternatively, 2 Advanced Highers and at least 4 Highers.

- National Swedish High School Diploma To be officially admitted on the recognized BA degree students are required to provide us with the Högskoleförberedande Examen. The Yrkesexamen is accepted too only if supplemented with passing grades (from E up to A) in the following courses: "Swedish" or "Swedish as a second language 2" and "Swedish as a second language 3", furthermore to "English 6". For evaluation purposes we require documents both in original language and translated.
- National Chinese High School Diploma Students obtaining a Chinese High School Diploma are required to provide NABA with copy of their Gaokao and Yikao exams.

Specific titles requirements are reported in detail in the MUR documents ALLEGATO 1 and ALLEGATO 2 published yearly on the Ministerial website www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri

STUDENTS WHO ATTENDED MORE THAN ONE UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION INSTITUTION

Diplomas obtained by students who, during their secondary education, moved from an institution within one education system to another within another education system (for example, from an Italian upper secondary school to an American high school), will only be considered valid if:

- the qualification was attained at the end of a total school education period of at least 12 years;
- the qualification was attained after at least 2 years of attendance of the same education system.
- [PREVIOUS YEARS OF EDUCATION] the qualification has been conferred after an overall path of at least 12 years of schooling. If the diploma was obtained after 10 or 11 years of education, it must be integrated with an additional 2 or 1 years, respectively, of college or university. All exams must be passed and admission respectively to the second or third year of the same university must be granted. Specifically for 11 years of previous education, it can be integrated with a Foundation Year. If you attended a Foundation Year, it is needed to provide all proper documentation concerning it; if you didn't attend a Foundation Year yet, please contact us for more information.
- Specific case for some <u>Latin American countries with 11 years of global schooling</u>, related to the Pre-Escolar year.

Only for *Peru, Costa Rica, Venezuela, Salvador, Guatemala* as an alternative to documentary evidence of one year of post-secondary or higher education studies (the above-mentioned Foundation year or further studies at University/Academy) students can matriculate to the Italian Universities/Academies by presenting documentary evidence of the Certificado de estudios of the *Pre-Escolar year*.

Even if also in **Colombia** students have the possibility take the pre-escolar year, Italian Embassy and Consulates do not accept it as a valid document to matriculate into Italian Universities/Academies, for this reason only European passports holders residing in this country are allowed to present documentary evidence of the Certificado de estudios of the *Pre-Escolar year*

- [National test or final exam necessary to enter a higher education institution] In case a national test or final exam is necessary to enter a higher education institution in the student's country of origin, such test/exam is also mandatory for entering Italian BA programmes (*Gao Kao and Yi Kao in China*, Vestibular in Brazil, YKS in Turkey, Selectividad in Spain etc.)
- [PROCESS TO BE DONE OVER FINAL SECONDARY SCHOOL OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS] legalize final Diploma, along with official document pertaining national test or final exam necessary to enter a higher education institution at the competent authority in the country where the diploma was issued, regardless of the school's actual location and, if necessary*, translate them into Italian by an official translator. For example, the diploma of a German school which is in France must be validated by the competent authority in Germany.

*Translation not necessary when documents are already officially issued in: Italian, English, French, Spanish.

Please notice that documents must be issued officially by the Highschool, but this is not sufficient when Legalizations are needed. In

fact, legalization is a specific process, which must be done at duly appointed government offices which contact details can be found here according to the country where your diploma was issued:

https://www.hcch.net/en/instruments/conventions/authorities1/?cid=41 . The legalization is not needed in case the title is obtained in one of the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France, Germany and Ireland and other possible country that may adhere to the European Convention of Brussels of 1987.

Legalizations can be substituted by the CIMEA Statement of Verification, which can be requested online at: https://cimea.diplo-me.eu/naba/#/auth/login. The school prefers to receive the CIMEA Statement of Verification instead of legalizations, however we give the student the final choice considering that legalizations could be requested by the Italian Diplomatic Authorities around the world for visa issuing. The student is anyway requested to present complete Diploma certificate (even if not legalized) duly translated in Italian if necessary.

The matriculation to the accredited programmes will stay conditional to the submission of the above-mentioned documents that will be evaluated by an appointed commission for matriculation purposes.

For any question about the validity of the student's diploma to access Italian Education System, we suggest to apply to CIMEA (Italian enic-naric center) Statement of comparability https://cimea-diplome.it/page-homepage. Upon accessing the official website, by selecting the country, you will be redirected to CIMEA document application or ARDI database https://ardi.cimea.it/en. Domus Academy reserves the right to ask, at any moment, for such documentation or additional one for evaluation and matriculation purposes.

If not in possession or the above-mentioned requirements, or needed documents are not submitted in time, students will be enrolled in **Diploma Program course** (please see section A. Audience) for more information.

F. STUDENTS WITH A PREVIOUS ACADEMIC CAREER AT A DIFFERENT UNIVERSITY REQUESTING FOR THE RECOGNITION OF PREVIOUS CREDITS AND EXAMS (TRANSFER STUDENTS)

BA programme applicants who have already attended university without completing a degree, can ask for the evaluation of their previous academic career and possible recognition of exams (TRANSFER STUDENTS).

With regards to the eligibility of their upper secondary school credentials, the same requirements listed for 1st year applicants also apply to transfer students. In addition, to request the evaluation of the previous academic career in order to get the transfer of recognisable exams and credits earned at a foreign university, students should be in possession of:

- 1. Academic transcripts of the first-cycle programme which should be equivalent in terms of level to the course that the student wishes to attend. The certificate should be issued by an official institution of the foreign education system and list all exams taken, grades received and credits assigned;
- 2. **Detailed study programmes:** description of the content covered by each course attended during the academic career, and the number of hours for each course/training activity in the academic curriculum, issued by an official institution of the foreign education system;

G. APPLICATION FOR A STUDY VISA TO ITALY (FOR NON-EUROPEAN STUDENTS ONLY)

Upon receiving the Enrolment Form filled in and signed and the pre-enrolment fee payment, the Admissions Office will provide students with all necessary information to apply for the student visa. For the 3-Year Bachelor or Arts Programme students are requested to have an entry visa for undergraduate study called **STUDIO per Immatricolazione Università tipo D nazionale**.

All students seeking for a study visa need to **start the pre-enrolment process through the Universitaly platform.** Universitaly is a website developed by the Italian Ministry for University and Research (MUR) with the aim of supporting students thorough their study experience in Italy. The MUR established that all International non-European students willing to study in an Italian Academy or University should undertake the pre-enrolment procedures through Universitaly.

The pre-enrolment will give you the possibility to study at Domus Academy - awarded institution "NABA, Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti" campus Milano - and allow you to obtain the study VISA from the Italian authorities. Students are asked to pre-enrol and submit a copy of the passport, English certificate, higher secondary school diploma on the Universitaly platform at https://www.universitaly.it/

In case the local school system consists of less than 12 years of schooling before achieving the higher secondary school diploma, the following documents are also required: legalized and translated university transcripts of one or two years, including exams and marks OR certificate of completion of preparatory courses (Foundation Course) issued by Italian or foreign universities.

Applications are usually open from March each year, approximately. Usually, it takes 90 days to get the study visa that is why we suggest you to start the procedure as soon as possible after your enrollment. Students are responsible to collect all needed information and proceed with visa application in a reasonable time to be sure to get visa prior course beginning.

H. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Application dossiers will be taken into consideration only if complete and received within the established deadlines.
- Programs will start only upon the attainment of a minimum number of enrolled students. In case the selected program will not start, Domus Academy will inform students within one month prior program beginning.
