### 2) WHAT PERSONAL DATA WE COLLECT

Nuova Accademia S.r.l. collects and stores your personal data at the time of enrolment/registration:

- identifying data such as given name, surname, residential address, email address, studies completed, citizenship, gender, place and date of birth, telephone number, copy of identity card/passport;
- your banking data and/or those belonging to the person making the payment;
- possible person to be contacted for administrative aspects, including payments;

- Academic career / curriculum vitae;

- student's images/recordings collected during events;
- data related to academic evaluations.

### 3.1) FOR WHAT PURPOSES WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Nuova Accademia S.r.l. uses your data for the following purposes:

### 5) THE SECURITY OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Your data will be processed using equipment that guarantees their confidentiality, integrity and availability. ## GENERAL INFORMATION:

### A. AUDIENCE

#### VALIDATION THROUGH NABA:

General entry requirements include:

- Holding a first level academic degree (Bachelor's Degree or Academic Diploma) in fields related to the selected study program
- Certificate of English language (IELTS 5.0 Academic or General on entry – see section H page 7)

The evaluation of an application is based on the positive assessment of both the Programme Leader and Admission Committee who will evaluate whether the degree and the technical skills corresponds to requirements, and will identify possible educational credits or debts.

Master's programmes are open also to students with not related degrees or diplomas, if the applicant is motivated by a research interest towards the programs' topics.

#### VALIDATION THROUGH REGENT'S UNIVERSITY LONDON:

General entry requirements include:

- **Holding a first level academic degree** (Bachelor's Degree or Academic Diploma) **not lower than 2:2** in fields related to the selected study program.  
Applications are opened also to students holding a Bachelor's Degree lower than 2:2 provided that they have also one year of relevant work experience. Students in such case could be requested to attend an interview with the Postgraduate Admissions Panel and/or to produce further documentation upon request.
- **Certificate of English language** (IELTS 5.5 overall and 5.5 in every single part on entry – see section H page 7)

The evaluation of an application is based on the positive assessment of both the Programme Leader and Admission Committee who will evaluate whether the degree and the technical skills corresponds to requirements, and will identify possible educational credits or debts.

Master's Programmes are open also to students with not related degrees or diplomas, if the applicant is motivated by a research interest towards the programs' topics.

#### DIPLOMA PROGRAM:

Participants not holding a first level Bachelor Degree/Academic Diploma will not earn the Academic Master's Degree/MA Degree and the educational credits. They will enroll into Diploma Program course following the course structure of the program validated by NABA - thus, they will not be allowed to enter the Double Award Master's Programme - and they will receive a **Domus Academy diploma** which is a private title, not recognized by MUR, Ministry for Universities and Research nor by Privy Council on successfully completing the program.

### B. ADMISSION PROCESS

Domus Academy Admissions Office will contact you as soon as possible to confirm the correct receiving of the application documents. The official feedback and results will be given according to the competition briefing deadlines. The admission will stay conditional until the **legalized University Degree and Transcripts** and the **required language certificate** are submitted to the school.

### C. ACADEMIC MASTER'S DEGREE (AWARDED BY NABA - 60 ECTS)

In order to receive an **Academic Master's Degree recognized by the Ministry for Universities and Research (MUR)**, students of the relevant Master's Programme have to be enrolled in NABA (Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti).

Upon receipt of the required documents (please see section E), the Admissions Office will proceed according to the necessary administrative steps.

NABA is a non-state institution belonging to the Ministry for Universities and Research (MUR). The Academic Master's Programmes lead to the attainment of legally recognized degrees and to the achievement of educational credits that will allow students to continue their studies in Academies and Universities in Italy and abroad.

### D. DOUBLE AWARD MASTER'S PROGRAMMES MA DEGREE (AWARDED BY REGENT'S UNIVERSITY LONDON - 90 ECTS)

Students eligible for the Double Award Master's Programme, upon the successful completion of the course and the positive assessment of the entry requirements, will receive, apart from the Academic Master's Degree awarded by NABA, a Master of Arts Degree awarded by Regent's University London and recognized by Privy Council UK.

For this reason, students of the relevant Master's Programme have to be registered at Regent's University London.

Upon receipt of the required documents (please see section E), the Admissions Office will proceed according to the necessary administrative steps.

### E. MINISTRY FOR UNIVERSITIES AND RESEARCH: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

In order to be eligible for admission to Italian universities/academies and therefore to be admitted into the NABA Academic Master Programmes, the Italian Ministry for University and Research has set the following mandatory regulations.

Students wishing to enrol in the Postgraduate Programmes are required to possess a first level university qualification which is considered eligible to enter the chosen programme. The title must meet the following requirements:

- be an official first cycle title belonging to the foreign system of reference and issued by an official institution of the foreign system;
- the title shall grant access to the second-cycle courses in the foreign system of reference;
- the applicant's academic qualification shall be equivalent to the Italian qualification required to enter second-cycle programmes.

These requirements apply to all students with a foreign qualification, regardless of their nationality, and is valid both for qualifications issued within the European Union and non-EU countries.

For any questions about the validity of your degree, we kindly suggest that you contact the Italian Enic-Naric Centre – CIMEA in the country where your degree was issued.

**In fact, enrolment to the Academic Master's Programmes and Master of Arts' Programmes will be confirmed only after having submitted the hardcopy of the Bachelor Degree legalized and translated, and Bachelor Transcripts legalized and translated (and any further documentation needed upon request) as well as the requested language certificate.**

## F. APPLICATION FOR A STUDY VISA TO ITALY (FOR NON EUROPEAN STUDENTS ONLY)

Upon receiving the Enrolment Form filled in and signed and the pre-enrolment fee payment, the Admissions Office will provide students with all necessary assistance in order to apply for the student visa.

For the One-year Academic Master Programme, students are requested to have an entry visa for post-graduate study called STUDIO Post-Laurea tipo D nazionale.

Starting from a.y. 2021/2022 all students seeking for a study visa need to fill the pre-enrollment form on UNIVERSITALY website (<https://www.universitaly.it/index.php/>). Universitaly is a platform launched by the Italian Ministry of University and Research (MUR) to monitor international students mobility studying in Italy.

## G. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Application dossiers will be taken into consideration only if complete and received within the established deadline.
- Programs will start only upon the attainment of a minimum number of enrolled students. In case the selected program will not start, Domus Academy will inform students within one month prior to program beginning.
- The present application form shall be considered read and approved in all its parts by the signature on page 3 and 5.

## H. ENGLISH LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE
