A. AUDIENCE

VALIDATION THROUGH NABA:

General entry requirements include:

- Holding a first level academic degree (Bachelor's Degree or Academic Diploma) in fields related to the selected study program
- Certificate of English language (IELTS 5.0 Academic on entry see section G page 5)

The evaluation of an application is based on the positive assessment of both the Programme Leader and Admission Committee who will evaluate whether the degree and the technical skills corresponds to requirements, and will identify possible educational credits or debts.

Master's programmes are open also to students with not related degrees or diplomas, if the applicant is motivated by a research interest towards the programs' topics.

VALIDATION THROUGH REGENT'S UNIVERSITY LONDON:

DIPLOMA PROGRAM:

Participants not holding a first level Bachelor Degree/Academic Diploma will not earn the Academic Master's Degree/MA Degree and the educational credits. They will enroll into Diploma Program course and they will receive a **Domus Academy diploma** which is a private title, not recognized by MIUR, Italian Ministry of Education University Research nor by Regent's University London UK on successfully completing the program.

B. ADMISSION PROCESS

Domus Academy Admissions Office will contact you as soon as possible to confirm the correct receiving of the application documents. The official feedback and results will be given according to the competition briefing deadlines. The admission will stay conditional until the declaration of value and the required language certificate are submitted to the school.

C. ACADEMIC MASTER'S DEGREE (AWARDED BY NABA - 60 ECTS)

In order to receive an **Academic Master's Degree recognized by the Italian Ministry of Education (MIUR)**, students of the relevant Master's Programme have to be enrolled in NABA (Nuova Accademia di Belle Arti).

Upon receipt of the required documents (please see section E), the Admissions Office will proceed according to the necessary administrative steps.

NABA is a non-state institution belonging to the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research (MIUR). The Academic Master's Programmes lead to the attainment of legally recognized degrees and to the achievement of educational credits that will allow students to continue their studies in Academies and Universities in Italy and abroad.

D. MA DEGREE (AWARDED BY REGENT'S UNIVERSITY LONDON - 90 ECTS)

In order to receive an **MA Degree awarded by Regent's University London**, students of the relevant Master's Programme have to be registered at Regent's University London.

Upon receipt of the required documents (please see section E), the Admissions Office will proceed according to the necessary administrative steps.

E. ITALIAN MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, UNIVERSITY AND RESEARCH: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students holding a non-Italian Bachelor's Degree shall contact the Italian Embassy or Consulate in the country where the degree was issued in order to ask for the so called **"perfezionamento documenti"**, consisting in:

- a. Legalization and translation into Italian made by a certified translator of the student's Bachelor's Degree.
- b. Legalization and translation into Italian made by a certified translator of the student's Academic Transcripts.
- c. "Dichiarazione di valore in loco" (Declaration of Value) of the student's Bachelor's Degree. The "Dichiarazione di valore in loco" is the document attesting that the study qualification obtained by the student is valid to study at Italian Universities or Academies.

The legalized and translated documents, as well as the "Dichiarazione di valore in loco" will be issued directly to you. Please make sure you submit them to Domus Academy Admissions Office as soon as available and anyway not later than the course beginning.

In fact, enrolment to the Academic Master's Programmes and Master of Arts' Programmes will be confirmed only after having submitted the hardcopy of the Declaration of Value and legalized translations as well as the requested language certificate.

F. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- $Application \ dossiers \ will be \ taken into \ consideration \ only \ if \ complete \ and \ received \ within \ the \ established \ deadline.$
- Programs will start only upon the attainment of a minimum number of enrolled students. In case the selected program will not start, Domus Academy will inform students within one month prior to program beginning.
- The present application form shall be considered read and approved in all its parts by the signature on page 3.

G. ENGLISH LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT FOR NABA VALIDATED PROGRAM AND DIPLOMA PROGRAM:

The English language requirement is **IELTS 5.0 Academic** or recognised equivalent certificate to be submitted **at least two months before the beginning of the Master's Programme** and should not be older than 2 years.

The following cases are exempt from the language test:

- Mother tongue students (prior check with the admission office)
- Bachelor's Degree Programs run in English (graduation date within 2 years prior the Master's Programme beginning). Please provide an **official university certificate** stating that English was the official and only medium of instruction (prior check with the admission office).

IMPORTANT: the official admission to Domus Academy programs is conditional to the actual achievement of the requested level of English language. Domus Academy reserves the right to check it through an internal language test when necessary.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT FOR REGENT'S UNIVERSITY LONDON VALIDATED PROGRAM

The English language requirement is **IELTS 5.5 Academic** or recognised equivalent certificate to be submitted at **least two** months before the beginning of the Master program and should not be older than 2 years.

The following cases are exempt from the language test:

- Graduate of a majority English speaking country such as: Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, The Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Dominica, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, New Zealand, St Kitts and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom, United States of America
- Bachelor's Degree Programs run in English (graduation date within 2 years prior the master's program beginning). Please provide an official university certificate stating that English was the official and only medium of instruction (prior check with the admission office).
- Successful completion of a UK pre-masters course, studied wholly in the UK (prior check with the admission office)

IMPORTANT: the official admission to Domus Academy programs is conditional to the actual achievement of the requested level of English language. Students not submitting a valid certificate will be asked to take an online test with an additional fee.
